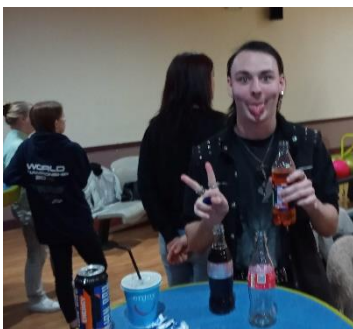
Funding News!
